Roger Kramer Memorial Scholarship 2024 Guidelines

Purpose

The Roger Kramer Memorial Scholarship, presented by the Tour de Donut bicycle ride, is designed to provide monetary support to graduating high school seniors and college-age students committed to a college or vocational education. The scholarship is a one-time contribution paid directly to the educational institution of enrollment.

Description

- The scholarship is for \$1,000 and will be paid directly to the student's educational institution in September or October during the fall academic term.
- The scholarship will be awarded to current year graduating high school seniors or currently enrolled college students.
- Annually, the Roger Kramer Memorial Scholarship Committee will decide the number of scholarships that will be awarded. The committee's decision will be based upon available funds in the Scholarship Reserve Account.
- A personal phone interview with each of the top finalists may be conducted as part of the selection process.

Qualifications

- Application for the scholarship must be submitted by the student to the Roger Kramer Scholarship Committee on or before the application due date of August 1, 2024.
- Applicant must be a high school senior graduating in spring/summer 2024 or a full-time student attending college or vocational school within the upcoming school year. (Typically this is September through the following May.)
- Applicant must be a "registered competitor" or "registered volunteer" of the Tour de Donut bicycle ride currently being held on July 13, 2024.
- The scholarship requires a minimum Grade Point Average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent for each year.
- A greater emphasis of awards will be towards applicants local to the Illinois/Missouri bistate area, academic aptitude, and a demonstrated enthusiasm for bicycling or bicycling activities.
- Previous Roger Kramer Memorial Scholarship winners are not eligible. Boeing Employees' Bicycle Club members and their immediate family are also not eligible.
